President - VACANT

The President oversees all activity of the organization and is a member of the Board. He/she is a partner with the Chairperson in achieving the organization's mission and report to the Board. He/she assists the Chairperson in developing the agenda for Board meetings. He/she appoints the chairpersons of committees, in consultation with the Chairperson and other Board members as needed. He/she serves ex officio as a member of committees and attends their meetings when invited. He/she discusses issues confronting the organization with the Chairperson and help guide and mediate actions relative to overall operation of the organization. He/she review with the Chairperson any issues of concern to the Board. He/she reviews reports on organizational matters with the Secretary and financial issues with the Treasure and in conjunction with both prepare an annual report on the organization and present it to the Board. He/she works closely with Directors of Membership, Programs and Events to assure the organizational mission. He/she serves as a primary volunteer of the organization and participates in event and program fund raising as required. In the event that the Chairperson is unable to serve for any reason; the President shall exercise all the powers and discharge all the duties of Chairperson until the Chairperson resumes the Chairperson's duties or an Chairperson's successor is chosen.

Secretary - VACANT

The Secretary maintains records of the organization, ensures effective management of organization's records and is a member of the Board. He/she produce minutes of board meetings and ensure He/she promptly distributes to all board members after each meeting. He/she will be sufficiently familiar with legal documents (articles, by-laws, IRS letters, etc.) to note applicability during meetings. In the absence of both the Chairperson and the President, the Secretary shall exercise all the powers and discharge all the duties of Chairperson until the Chairperson or the President shall be able to resume the Chairpersons duties or until an Chairperson's successor is chosen.

Treasurer - VACANT

The Treasurer shall have the general supervision of the financial affairs of the organization and is a member of the board. He/she shall be the Chairman of the Finance Committee and perform the entire duties incident to the office and such other duties assigned by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer may sign any check or other order of the 7x24 Exchange International, Northern California Chapter for the payment or transfer of money. The Treasurer produces an annual report on the financial conditions of the 7x24 Exchange International, Northern California Chapter for presentation to the membership and for the Board of Directors.

Director of Membership - VACANT

The Director of Membership sets the tone for the membership recruitment and is a member of the Board. He/she ensures that membership materials are updated and membership lists are accurately kept. He/she report to the Chairman of the Board. He/she regularly reports to the full Board on membership activity at Board meetings. He/she works closely with the President and Board as agreed to by the President to recruit new members. He/she plans, develops and directs logistics for membership recruitment. He/she shall oversee all membership recruitment efforts. He/she annually accesses the membership and provides an evaluation to the board. He is responsible for the maintenance and new entries to the membership database.

End User Representative - VACANT

The End User Representative is the liason to all End User members and heads communication, membership efforts, committee and work groups that target End User needs and activities. This Board Member shall be an active End User.

Director of Events - VACANT

The Director of Events sets the tone for events and is a member of the Board. He/she ensures that event materials are accurate and of professional nature. He/she reports to the Chairman of the Board. He/she regularly reports to the full Board on pending events activities at board meetings. He/she works closely with the Director of Programs to assure that Programs and Events are closely aligned. He/she oversees the logistics of both Programs and Events relative to where, timing and costs etc. associated to both. He/she works closely with the President and other board as agreed to by the President to develop events. He/she plans, develops and directs logistics of events for general membership. He/she oversees all efforts relative to Events. He/she annually accesses activities relative to Events and provide an evaluation to the board. He/She is responsible for developing and maintaining the Chapter website and emailing campaigns.

(1) Directors at Large (Advisory Board Members) - 1 Position VACANT

The Director at Large makes serious commitment to participate actively in assisting other board members and committees when needed. He/she regularly attend board meetings and important related meetings of the organization. He/she volunteers for and willingly accepts assignments and completes them thoroughly and on time. He/she stays informed about board matters; prepare themselves well for board meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports. He/she gets to know other board members and builds a collegial working relationship that contributes to

a consensus. He/she actively participates in the board's annual evaluation and planning efforts. He/she participates in event and program fund raising as required. This role is advisory and does not include voting authority.
